


## iNYP Tutorial

### What is iNYP?

- iNYP is a clinical data review and summarization application which allows users to view clinical data from both NYP/WCMC (East Campus) and NYP/CUMC (West Campus) in a single application. West campus data dates back to 1989 and East campus data is from 2007. The addition of clinical data from regional hospitals started in 2016 and is ongoing as we are actively striving to incorporate data from all Regional Hospitals. The iNYP FAQ document, found under the [Help](#) link in the bottom footer, outlines the data that are available from the NYP Regional Hospitals and Medical Groups.
- iNYP is available directly from any browser, including mobile devices, at <http://inyp.nyp.org>. It is also available via a *tab* in NYP EHR applications Allscripts SCM at NYP/CUMC, at NYP/WCMC, and at NYP/Q and in ColumbiaDocs EHR application CROWN at CUMC.

67 y/o F PMH HIV (CD4 ~950, VL undetectable), uncontrolled DM, HTN, HLD, NIDCM (LVEF 50%) s/p AICD, asthma, and MGUS, who was now admitted w/ N/V and finding of AKI and nephrotic-range proteinuria.

The patient reports that s and abdominal bloating following adjust frequent N/V and anorexia w/ wt loss. 
